

LIGHT INKJET TRANSFER PAPER INSTRUCTIONS

Only use 100% cotton fabrics that have been prewashed without any detergent, softener or dryer sheets.

PRINTING:

Only feed one sheet at a time through your printer.

Select the "plain paper" setting at 720dpi.

Print in "mirror image" select this option in your software and image on the white side of the paper.

If your print is too light increase the saturation and if it's too dark decrease.

Let the print dry for 24 hours.

Cut around image area leaving no more than ¼" and make sure all corners are rounded off.

IRONING

Use a very hard, stable and smooth surface as a base for the transferring. (An ironing board is too soft)

Place a pillowcase or some thick fabric between the hard surface and the inkjet transfer paper, make sure it is wrinkle free and iron it first if need be.

Lay your t-shirt or fabric without any creases onto the base. (Make sure t-shirt or fabric is prewashed)

Place your image face down onto the fabric and align exactly where you want it.

Empty out all the water from the iron first. Set your iron on the highest setting, 320f. without any steam.

Press firmly down and hold in one position for 20-30 seconds.

Never move iron without lifting straight up first!

Lift up and move to next position and repeat. Make sure to overlap image at least an inch.

Lift and move iron until the entire surface (include all edges and corners) has been covered.

Let transfer paper cool to the touch (about 1 minute) and remove backing material starting at the corner.

For increased resistance to peeling, put a sheet of wax paper (purchase from grocery store) over the image and repeat the ironing process once again.

Your image is now transferred to your t-shirt or fabric!

WASHING

Do not wash for at least a full 24 hours after ironing.

Turn t-shirt or fabric inside out before washing.

Machine washable on cold delicate setting. (Do not use any detergent the first time)

Hang drying is recommended but can be used in dryer under air-low temperature setting.

Never iron t-shirt or fabric directly on imaged area without wax paper covering it.

You can increase the durability of your image by ironing with wax paper after every wash.
